Transporting Equipment

Important items to consider when transporting equipment:

1. Plan Your Route

- Choose the safest and most efficient route, avoiding narrow roads and bridges.
- Be aware of road conditions and hazards such as overhead lines.
- If possible, transport equipment when less traffic is present.

2. Secure the Load

- Use appropriate tie-downs, chains, and binders to secure the equipment.
- Double-check all connections to ensure they are tight and secure.

3. Follow Weight Limits

- Do not exceed the vehicle's weight capacity.
- Be aware of the combined weight of the vehicle and equipment and avoid overloading on posted roads and bridges.

4. Use Proper Signage

- Display appropriate warning signs and lights on the vehicle.
- Use flags or escort vehicles if required by local regulations.

5. Drive Safely

- Maintain a safe speed and keep a safe distance from other vehicles.
- Stay alert and be cautious when making turns or changing lanes.
