Sump Pump Safety

Avoid Overloading: Do not overload the sump pit with debris, as this can hinder the pump's operation.


Proper Ventilation: Ensure the sump pit is well-ventilated to avoid the buildup of harmful gases.


Use Appropriate Equipment: Only use pumps designed for sump applications to ensure safety and efficiency.
